

Stafford Fish & Game 2023 Skeet League



March 11 – May 28 2023 – Spring Session

July 29 – October 16 2023 -Summer Session

League Dinner – 07 October 23

All rounds must be completed by end the last scheduled day of the session

- \$20 Dollar per Session Fee (all proceeds go to League Dinner)
- \$4 (Members) \$5 (non-members) per round skeet cost (paid to the club, shooter responsibility)
- Shooter supplies own ammo.
- “A” League is for shooters with average higher than 20
- “B” League is for shooters with average lower than 20**
- 14 rounds are used for scoring (14 rounds, 350 shots)
 - Rank score is determined by total score clays hit
- 1st place A League shooter’s name is engraved on the club plaque as Champion
 - **Shooters in “B” league will be placed in “A” league for the next league if final average is 20 or above
- Time – At your leisure, Club skeet range rules apply
- To accommodate schedules, shooters may complete rounds on their own, no weekly round limit. Scores need to be witnessed.
- A and B league can shoot together
- Non-league members should not shoot during league scoring unless league shooters accept.
- Score sheets available at the skeet range (High House)
 - Please leave completed score sheets on the skeet field sign in clipboard at the club! Or text a photo to Carl Berner.
- National Skeet Shooting Association (NSSA) rules apply*
 - *Exception – no score handicap for smaller gauges
- Experienced and new shooters welcome!
- Results announced at the Club meetings following the session
